



The Chatham Charter PTSA will hold a chicken tender dinner on February 12, 2016. Following are some frequently asked questions about this event.

Q. Where is the event?

A. Chatham Charter School, 2200 Hamp Stone Rd in Siler City

Q. What time is the event?

A. Noon-7pm

Q. Dine in or takeout?

A. Takeout orders will be available noon-7pm. Dine-in will be from 4-7pm.

Q. How much are tickets?

A. Tickets are \$8 per plate and include chicken tenders, green beans, bread, slaw, dessert and drink.

Q. What is the event benefitting?

A. All profits will go toward the Ronnie Joyce Outdoor Recreation & Learning Center at Chatham Charter School. The vision for the park includes a playground, refurbished outdoor basketball courts and swings, raised garden beds, improved landscaping, additional sun shades and seating areas, outdoor classroom space and science lab, as well as a small arts stage. Fundraising has been ongoing for two years, and this is the final fundraiser before construction begins. Construction is set to begin in Summer 2016, and will be completed in phases dependent upon final funds raised. **\*\*Additionally, a portion of the proceeds will go to the Joyce family to help defray medical costs they have incurred as Mr. Joyce has fought brain cancer for the past two years.\*\***

Q. How many tickets are you selling?

A. 3,000

Q. Are tickets required?

A. Tickets are not required, however, we have a limit of 3,000 plates and advance ticket purchases helps greatly with event planning

- Q. I am part of Chatham Charter and I want to buy/sell tickets. How do I do this?
- A. We are asking students and staff to each sell a minimum of five tickets to reach our goal of 3,000 tickets. You ask friends and family to buy tickets, keep track of how many tickets you need and collect the money. Turn in the form with the information filled out along with the money collected every Wednesday to the school through homerooms (elementary/middle school students) or houses (high school students). Tickets will be sent home with your child the week of the dinner.
